## PUBLIC NOTICE CITY OF DANVILLE 2023-2024 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

The City of Danville is a participating jurisdiction under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investments Partnership programs. Basic goals are (1) Decent Housing, (2) Suitable Living Environment, and (3) Expanded Economic Opportunities. All funded activities must address one or more national program objectives: benefit low- to moderate income persons, aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight, or meet an urgent community need for which no other funds are available. The City has prepared a one-year Action Plan that specifies projects and activities to be funded during the coming year. The City's HUD grant is anticipated to be \$1,248,966 for fiscal year 2023-2024 (7/1/2023 – 6/30/2024), comprised of \$853,442 CDBG funds, \$335,524 HOME funds, and \$60,000 estimated program income.
