The City Council will hold a Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m. at its scheduled Council Meeting on Tuesday, June 18, 2024, in Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, Municipal Building, 427 Patton Street, Danville, Virginia.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to provide all interested parties an opportunity to speak to the City's application to the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation for financial assistance for the City of Danville Transit System for FY 2025. The amount of the City's application for state operating assistance is \$786,477 and federal operating aid is \$2,068,363. A total of \$844,000 in federal capital aid and \$436,515 in state capital aid is requested to replace three 14-passenger buses, install four bus shelters, install a new bus wash system and complete maintenance building modifications. The estimated total cost for capital improvements is \$1,333,870 and the estimated local match requirement for capital projects is \$54,355.

The proposed Program of projects will be adopted as the Program of Projects. In the event the proposed Program of Projects is amended as a result of the Public Hearing, the amended Program of Projects will be adopted.
