In re: Extension of Declaration of Judicial Emergency

Pursuant to the Third Order Extending Declaration of Judicial Emergency issued by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Virginia on April 22, 2020, the Court hereby orders all cases scheduled to be presented at the regular term of Grand Jury for the May/June 2020 term of court previously scheduled to be held on May 4, 2020, shall hereby be ordered to be presented at a Grand Jury proceeding on May 18, 2020 or a such date as the Court may prescribe pursuant to the Declaration of Judicial Emergency.

Furthermore, the Court orders that all fines, costs and restitution payments are suspended from the period of March 16, 2020 until June 1, 2020 with interest being waived.

The Court directs that this order be certified to the Virginia Supreme Court, the Danville General District Court and Juvenile & Domestic Relations District Court, and to the Commonwealth Attorney's Office.
