MATERIALS THAT CAN BE RECYCLED IN DANVILLE:

CARDBOARD ✓ Corrugated, packaging boxes

No wax-coated cardboard

GLASS Please rinse and remove lids

☑ Clear or colored

No broken glass, plate glass, pyrex,

dinnerware, or bulbs

MIXED PAPER ☑ Magazines, newspaper, cereal

boxes, paper rolls, paperback

books, etc.

✓ Shredded paper (must be bagged)

METALS
☑ Aluminum cans, beverage cans,

food cans, steel cans, soup cans,

and small scrap metal

PLASTIC Please rinse and remove lids

☑ Type 1 (PETE)

Water and soda bottles

☑ Type 2 (HDPE)

Milk jugs, detergent, oil, shampoo, etc.

A diamond-shaped code should be molded into the plastic item. This symbol provides visible information for sorting purposes.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING:

AUTO FLUIDS Anti-freeze, motor oil, brake fluids, etc.

Take to any auto service / part store

BATTERIES Auto or other

BULBS Fluorescent, incandescent, or tubular

PLASTIC BAGS

PLASTIC: Type 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7

Type 3 (V) Plastic pipes, shower curtains, medical tubing, vinyl dashboards, and even some baby bottle nipples

Type 4 (LDPE) Grocery and sandwich bags, shrink wrap.

Type 5 (PP) Refrigerated containers, some bags, most bottle tops, some carpets, food wrapping.

Type 6 (PS) Styrofoam (i.e. coffee cups), throwaway utensils, meat packing, protective packing (i.e. peanuts).

Type 7 (OTHER) Usually layered or mixed plastic.

OTHER Food packaging (i.e. pizza boxes, egg cartons)

- Tractor Supply on Piney Forest Road
- South Boston Road / Halifax Road

OTHER RECYCLABLES:

ELECTRONICS Bring to E-Recycling Center at PW

Electronics (i.e. computers, cell phones, microwaves, etc.) **No TVs or CRTs**.

TIRES Bring to E-Recycling Center at PW

\$5.00 per passenger, light truck tire \$10.00 per heavy truck tire

Pay at Public Works Office before drop off.

APPLIANCES Call Public Works to schedule

pickup for a fee:

\$15 each for non-refrigerants \$40 each for refrigerants or take to a local recycler.

SUBSCRIPTION CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Curbside Recycling Service is available to city residents for \$3.75 per collection. Pick up is on the first and third Thursday of each month. Set your container(s) at curbside, filled with comingled recyclable materials. The July to June annual service fee of \$90 is paid in advance at the Public Works Office. (The fee is

pro-rated if application is made after July 1st.) Public Works will provide containers. Application forms are available at Public Works or online at http://www.danville-va.gov/
