ZONING AND BUSINESS IN DANVILLE



DOING BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF DANVILLE



- BEFORE you sign a lease, call to check the zoning of the property.
- We check to make sure the proposed business is in the correct zoning district.
- We check to make sure the property does not have outstanding code violations.
- We *may* inspect the property to make sure there are no other issues.





DOING BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF DANVILLE

Zoning is reviewed when:

- A change of use requires a new certificate of occupancy; AND/OR
- The Commissioner of Revenue receives a business license application.

CITY OF DANVILLE MOBILE FOOD VENDOR GUIDELINES



PREPARATION

- Prior to your event, please obtain your:
- Health Permit and Inspection from the Virginia Department of Health;
- Fire Suppression Inspection from the Danville Fire Marshal's Office:
 City of Danville Rusiness License from the Commissioner of
- City of Danville Business License from the Commissioner of Revenue; and
 Model and the Commissioner of the Commissione
- Meals Tax Remittance information from the Commissioner
 of Revenue.

LOCATION

When it comes to City property and streets, you cannot: • Set up within 50' feet of a permanent restaurant;

- Set up within 50 feet of a permanent restaurant;
 Set up on Danville Parks and Recreation property without
- permission; • Set up on a street where the speed limit is more than 25 mbh;
- Set up in a location not zoned for restaurants;
- · Set up within 10' of another mobile food vendor or building;
- Take up more than one parking spot; or
- Block vehicle traffic or pedestrian flow.

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OPERATION During your event, please:

- Have a garbage can on-site to prevent littering and clean up when you are finished;
- Do not discharge any liquids from your mobile food vehicle;
 Make sure ordering and pickup lines do not block sidewalks
- or streets; and • Move locations or stop vending during an emergency if police officers or public safety personnel request so.
