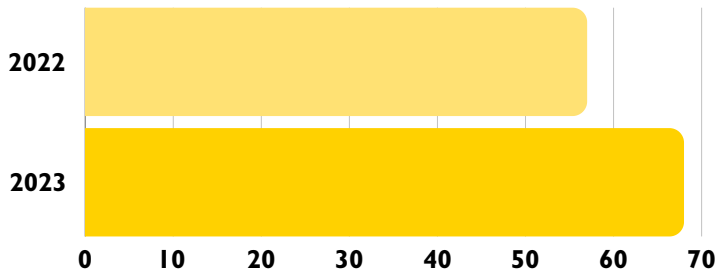

WHY RECYCLE GLASS?

Glass recycling contributes to the overall health and well-being of communities. It conserves energy and natural resources while also reducing waste.

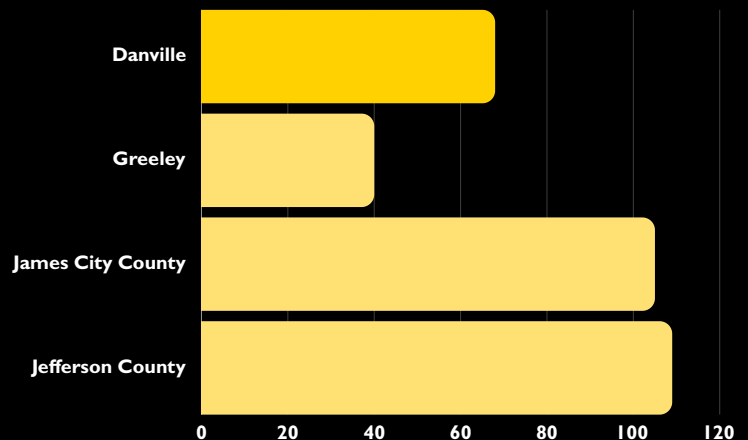
GLASS4GOOD™ is a program developed by O-I to increase glass recycling in every community in which they operate. Through collaboration with the City of Danville, residents can safely and properly recycle their glass at four designated collection sites. After processing, the collected glass (cullet) from Danville's GLASS4GOOD™ program is used at O-I's closest facility and is formed into new glass, sometimes in as little as 30 days. To further impact the community through glass recycling, O-I also provides a charitable donation to United Way of Danville-Pittsylvania County based on the weight of collected glass.

UNITED WAY INITIATIVES:

United Way of Danville and Pittsylvania County has designated four areas of focus: Read Dan River, Educate Dan River, Get Healthy Dan River, and Work Dan River. In 2023, United Way allocated the donations from GLASS4GOOD™ to support Danville Pittsylvania Cancer Association (DPC), an agency that falls under the Get Healthy Dan River Initiative.

Glass4Good donations have helped Danville Pittsylvania Cancer to provide:



Travel Services

DPC offers reimbursement for travel expenses incurred to cancer-related medical appointments for chemotherapy and other related oncology visits. They also offer overnight lodging and lodging reimbursement for emergency treatments and early appointments.



Prescription Aid

DPC assists cancer patients with the cost of their cancer-related prescriptions prescribed by their oncologist. They also have accounts with local pharmacies, where their clients can pay for their prescriptions with DPC's account. The organization understands how expensive and complicated it can be to manage many medications, and they aim to make everything stress-free.



Supplies

DPC provides cancer-related supplies, such as: nutritional supplements, adult incontinence supplies, wigs, hats/turbans, mastectomy bras, and prosthesis. They provide supplies for both youth and adult needs and aim to provide the most high-quality supplies available.



Emotional Support

DPC's COPING cancer support group is where those actively receiving treatments, survivors, and caregivers can all gather to share thoughts and offer help to one another. COPING meetings are offered on the last Tuesday of every month.
