WHY RECYCLE GLASS?

Glass recycling contributes to the overall health and well-being of communities. It conserves energy and natural resources while also reducing waste.

GLASS4GOOD™ is a program developed by O-I to increase glass recycling in every community in which they operate. Through collaboration with the City of Danville, residents can safely and properly recycle their glass at four designated collection sites. After processing, the collected glass (cullet) from Danville's GLASS4GOOD™ program is used at O-I's closest facility and is formed into new glass, sometimes in as little as 30 days. To further impact the community through glass recycling, O-I also provides a charitable donation to United Way of Danville-Pittsylvania County based on the weight of collected glass.

MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN DANVILLE

Through United Way of Danville-Pittsylvania County, Danville's GLASS4GOOD™ program currently benefits Danville Pittsylvania Cancer (DPC), a nonprofit organization focused on improving the quality of life for local cancer patients by providing access to services needed to help in their battle against cancer. Patient services include aid in the form of travel reimbursement for clients traveling out of town for treatments.

Since the beginning of this partnership with DPC, Danville's GLASS4GOOD™ has provided funding for DPC clients to attend 175 appointments with over 14,464 miles reimbursed. This is no small feat, as each visit means a cancer patient is receiving lifesaving treatment. Danville Pittsylvania Cancer extends their deepest thanks to United Way of Danville-Pittsylvania County and Danville's GLASS4GOOD™ program for selecting them as the beneficiary of these funds.

- Beer/wine/champagne/ spirits/ non-alcoholic beverage glass bottles
- Food glass jars/containers

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR RECYCLING:

- Windows
- Mirrors
- Light bulbs
- Solar panels
- Heat-resistant glass (e.g. Pyrex)
- Drinking glasses
- Computer/TV screens
