WHY RECYCLE GLASS?

Glass recycling contributes to the overall health and well-being of communities. It conserves energy and natural resources while also reducing waste.

GLASS4GOOD[™] is a program developed by O-I to increase glass recycling in every community in which they operate. Through collaboration with the City of Danville, residents can safely and properly recycle their glass at four designated collection sites. After processing, the collected glass (cullet) from Danville's GLASS4GOOD[™] program is used at O-I's closest facility and is formed into new glass, sometimes in as little as 30 days. To further impact the community through glass recycling, O-I also provides a charitable donation to United Way of Danville-Pittsylvania County based on the weight of collected glass.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR RECYCLING:

- Windows
- Mirrors
- Light bulbs
- Solar panels
- Heat-resistant glass (e.g. Pyrex)
- Drinking glasses
- Computer/TV screens
