Adopt-A-Spot Program

Program Intent:

The intent of the Adopt-A-Spot program is to encourage citizen participation in beautification and litter clean-ups of designated areas in their community at regular intervals. Individuals, organizations, or businesses may agree to keep a designated area, other than a highway, cleared of litter and/or provide beautification for a contract period of either on or two years.

In return, volunteers will be given materials to help them with the clean-ups, as well as a sign bearing their names posted in their designated area. At the end of their contract, they will receive a special certificate of appreciation and may renew their agreement.

This program is modeled after the Virginia Department of Transportation's Adopt-A-Highway program, and is intended to provide City residents or groups with a means to make the City of Danville a cleaner, more beautiful place for all.

Program Terms:

- 1. Any individual (18 years or older), community group, children's organization (supervised by adults), special interest, business, church, or other group may adopt public areas in Danville.
- 2. Public areas are streets (other than highways or their median strips) parks, schools, vacant lots owned by the City, parking lots, and other publicly held lands.
- 3. The adopting individual(s) or organization(s) commit to cleaning up their adopted areas at least four times each year (once a quarter) for two years.
- 4. If participants are unable to fulfill their agreement, their signs will be removed.
- 5. Participants are required to track and report on their clean-up activities to the City of Danville Public Works Department so that information may be used for various reports and analyses.
- 6. Groups with participating members less than 15 years of age must be supervised by an adult of at least 21 years of age.
- 7. Participants must attend an initial safety briefing prior to the first clean-up to review safety and other guidelines. This briefing will be given by the Adopt-A-Spot Coordinator. No participant may be involved in a litter clean-up without having attended at least one safety briefing.
- 8. Public Works will provide participants with plastic trash bags and safety vests (if clean-up involves a street) prior to each clean-up.
- 9. Participants will be advised on how to dispose of filled trash bags. Participants are encouraged to separate recyclable materials.
- 10. A sponsor sign noting the program and participating organization will be erected at the designated Adopt-A-Spot location, and shall be made according to specifications and material supplied by the commission.
- 11. After each clean-up, adopting organizations will be asked to provide a simple report. Report forms will be given to each organization's lead representative. If the lead representative is not expected to be at the clean-up site, this report should be given to their designee. This report will include information such as date, hours worked, number or persons involved in clean-up, number of bags collected, etc. This report should be mailed to the City of Danville Public Works Department within one week after clean-up.
- 12. The Adopt-A-Spot coordinator, in conjunction with the City of Danville Public Works Department, will monitor the designated areas of adoption.
- 13. City of Danville reserves the right to make changes to these terms as necessary.
- 14. City of Danville is not responsible for any accident or injury that occurs to any member of any organization, or their property, that participates in the City of Danville Adopt-A-Spot Program and all members, volunteers of organizations and organizations hereby waive any and all claims against the City for any injury to any property or persons participating in this program.

It is understood that the applicant is not an employee or volunteer of the City while participating in the Adopt-A-Spot program. As such, City of Danville is not providing any worker's compensation for acts or omissions of applicant while engaged in any activities arising out of or related to this Adopt-A-Spot agreement and program.

It is further understood that the City will not defend, hold harmless, or indemnify the applicant for any claims of loss, injury, death, or damage arising out of or related to this Adopt-A-Spot agreement and program.

This Agreement and the performance thereof shall be governed by and enforced under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and if legal action by either party is necessary for or with respect to the enforcement of any or all of the terms and conditions hereof, then exclusive venue therefore shall lie in the City of Danville, Virginia.
