

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City Council will hold a Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m., or as soon after as may be heard, at its scheduled Council Meeting on Tuesday, June 17, 2025, in Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, Municipal Building, 427 Patton Street, Danville, Virginia.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to provide all interested parties an opportunity to speak to the City's application to the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation for financial assistance for the City of Danville Transit System for FY 2026. The amount of the City's application for state operating assistance is \$758,875 and federal operating aid is \$2,112,050. A total of \$552,276 in federal capital aid and \$1,341,242 in state capital aid is requested to replace five 14-passenger and three 28-passenger buses, complete roof repairs for the mass transit administrative and maintenance facility and crack seal and seal coat the mass transit parking lots. The estimated total cost for capital improvements is \$1,972,415 and the estimated local match requirement for capital projects is \$78,897.

The proposed Program of projects will be adopted as the Program of Projects. In the event the proposed Program of Projects is amended as a result of the Public Hearing, the amended Program of Projects will be adopted.

Copies of the grant applications and the proposed expenditures are available for public review at the Danville Regional Airport.
