GUIDELINES FOR THE PROPER USE OF ROLLING REFUSE CARTS

- 1. Bag all household garbage and place inside approved container/cart.
- 2. The only items of solid waste collected outside of the cart will be large bulk debris, such as an empty box, that cannot be reduced to fit into a complying automated cart.
- 3. A limit of four (4) large bulk items, such as chairs, sofas, mattresses, etc., are acceptable per pick up.
- 4. Large quantities of small debris, generated as a result of garage or household cleanouts or special events, will require rental of a trailer or pay for a special pick up.
- 5. Set container out by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day, or the evening prior.
- 6. Place container within three (3) feet from the curb or edge of road.
- 7. Place container on a flat surface, if possible.
- 8. Cart handle should face the house with the front facing the street.
- 9. Trash that will not fit into container, may <u>not</u> be placed on top of or outside of the container. Additional carts are available for purchase.
- 10. Do not place loose trash, hazardous material, or hot ashes inside container.
- 11. Do not place cart within three (3) feet of any obstruction, such as a pole, mailbox, tree, vehicle, guide wire, etc.
- 12. Store household garbage on private property between collection days in a clean and sanitary condition.
- 13. Maintenance or replacement of carts, due to theft or damage, is the responsibility of the property owner. It is recommended that residents paint identifying information on their cart, such as the address.

<u>EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2011</u>: Residential household trash must be placed at the curbside / roadside by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled day of collection.
