ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF ADDENDUM IN SPACE PROVIDED ON THE BID FORM. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY SUBJECT THE BIDDER TO DISQUALIFICATION.

The Contract Documents and Contract Drawings are revised as follows:

Questions from Contractor:

- Sheet 7 states that no equipment can be left in a lane closure during non-working hours. Can it be allowed to leave equipment in a closed lane on Central Blvd. if it is protected with a truck mounted attenuator? A: Yes, Contractor can leave equipment in a closed lane on Central Blvd. (Rte. 86) if it is protected with a truck mounted attenuator.
- 2. Are temporary Pavement Line markings required on W Main Street? Sheets 8 & 9 of the plan set indicate temporary pavement line markings in a legend with the designation letters 'A' and 'B' but they are not shown in the traffic control layout for stage 1. Sheets 10 &11 also indicate temporary pavement line markings in the legend but the layout only shows the location of 'A', the 'B' on sheet 10 is incorrectly shown and is not shown at all on sheet 11.

A: Yes, Temporary pavement line markings are required on W. Main Street. Please see the attached revised plan sheets 1, 8, 9, 10 & 11.

Could you please provide a description of what is to be included in the bid item "General Maintenance"? There is typically a note in the plans or a special provision in the project manual, but I cannot locate it in the documents.
A: Please see plan sheet 3, 2nd paragraph under VII Incidentals concerning "General Maintenance – Lump Sum".












LOCATION MAP (Not to Scale)
